JANJ Fireside Chat: An opportunity to tell your story, inspire our next generation of leaders & provide hope for students— remotely!

A fireside chat is an informal yet structured interview between a moderator and a guest. JANJ's Career-Focused Fireside Chat is a unique opportunity to uncover the speaker's stories and experiences, and can be done one-on-one or with a small group.



How to record a Fireside Chat

<u>Step 1</u> - Contact <u>Stephanie Karpowicz</u> to schedule a **one hour** session over WebEx.

<u>Step 2</u> - Sign the electronic <u>JA Media Release</u> form (required for all volunteers).

<u>Step 4</u> - Review suggested Career Questions and think about your responses—what would you have wanted to hear when you were in high school?

Step 5 - Attend session (approx. 1 hour total)

Session Agenda:

- 20 minutes prep, run through, technology practice.
- 15-20 minutes to record the Fireside Chat.
- 10 debrief/reflection on the session.

Career Questions 15-20 minutes

Select a few questions to answer during the Fireside Chat recording. . .

- Introduce yourself and your company or organization.
- Share your "job story" How many different types of jobs have you had? Did all of them relate to your current position?
- What did you learn from your first job? Do you feel that those skills were transferable?
- Discuss your education path did it guide you to the career or did things change along the way?
- What advice would you give to your younger self?
- Are there resources or additional information you think is important for students to know if they are interested in learning more about the type of work you do?
- Feel free to add a topic that is important to you. Whether it is the importance of mentorship, work/life balance, reducing inequities, or overcoming obstacles. Someone can always relate!

How will this video be used?

Fireside Chats are regularly added to JANJ's <u>YouTube</u> <u>channel</u>, giving middle and high school students easy access to learn about the key career clusters, jobs and employers in New Jersey!
